The disappearance of Jesus' body from the tomb has been one of the greatest mysteries and most controversial topics of all time. It is a problem beyond explanation unless we accept the testimony of the early Disciples that God raised Him from the dead!

The New Testament testifies to the fact that Jesus was seen alive after His death and appeared to more than five-hundred eyewitnesses, including His brother James, who was originally a sceptic, but later converted after he saw the risen Lord.

We have at our disposition powerful historical evidence which proves the reports were not the product of legendary development, as some critics continue to insist.

However, what makes the Apostles' testimony even more valid is their faithfulness to respect even the smallest instruction their Master commanded them to obey. Below are just a few examples.

And when James and Cephas and John, who were acknowledged pillars, recognized the grace that had been given to me, they gave to Barnabas and me the right hand of fellowship, agreeing that we should go to the Gentiles and they to the circumcised.

(Galatians 2:9-10)

For when one says, "I belong to Paul," and another, "I belong to Apollos," are ye not merely human? What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you came to believe, as the Lord assigned to each.

(1 Corinthians 3:4-6)

So also our beloved brother Paul wrote to you according to the wisdom given him, speaking of this as he does in all his letters.

(2 Peter 3:15)
